2025 Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation Scholarship Program Information

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation Scholarship Program is to encourage and promote the attainment of higher education goals for youth who have demonstrated a high level of achievement during high school or college, are in need of financial assistance, and have shown an interest in the game of golf.

ELIGIBILITY:

It is not required that applicants for the 2025 Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation Scholarship Program be skilled junior golfers. The applicant's golfing ability will not be the determining factor in the evaluation process. Details of the applicant's involvement in golf will be requested in the applicant. Applicants must currently reside within the geographic boundaries of the Alabama – NW Florida PGA Section.

Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance to meet educational expenses.

Applicants must be enrolled (or planning to enroll) as a full-time student beginning in the fall of 2025. A <u>full-time</u> student is defined as one who is taking 12 or more hours in a course of study leading to a traditional associate (<u>2-year</u>) or baccalaureate (<u>4-year</u>) degree at an accredited college or university located within the United States, or considered a full-time student by his or her respective institution.

The Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation Scholarship Committee will review the student's class ranking, grade point average (GPA), ACT or SAT test scores, extracurricular activities, and financial need. The student should be enrolled in a college-bound curriculum. Distinguished honors should be noted.

The applicant's high school cumulative grade point average MUST BE AT LEAST 2.5 ON a 4.0 GRADING SCALE or the student WILL NOT be considered eligible for the scholarship program. College students applying for any Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation scholarship MUST HAVE A MINIMUM of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.

The awarding of Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation Scholarships is contingent upon other financial aid, grants, and/or scholarships that may be awarded to the applicant. The Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation reserves the right to revoke any commitment to extend scholarship benefits to any applicant receiving any other form of financial aid, grants, and/or scholarship for attendance at an accredited four-year college or university or an accredited two-year college. Notice of this policy will be given by the Alabama – NW Florida Golf Foundation to all educational institutions to which applicants have applied.

Limit – Individuals are limited to receiving a scholarship from the Alabama NW-Florida Golf Foundation two times in their collegiate career.

ALABAMA – NW FLORIDA GOLF FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS:

1.) JUNIOR GOLF ALABAMA / JUNIOR TOUR SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY (\$2,500)

Along with the above criteria mentioned in the overall scholarship eligibility guidelines, the applicant must have been a previous member of the Alabama – NW Florida PGA Junior Tour from 2010-2022. Participation in Junior Golf Alabama events since it began in 2023 satisfies the Junior Tour requirements.

2.) SON, DAUGHTER, OR GRANDCHILD SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY (\$2,500)

Along with the criteria mentioned in the overall scholarship eligibility guidelines, the applicant must be a son, daughter, grandchild or have some direct lineal relation (great-grandchild, etc.) to an Alabama – NW Florida PGA Section Member in good standing.

NOTE: Children and grandchildren/great-grandchildren, etc. of the members of the Scholarship Selection Committee are not eligible to apply for scholarships.
